SHEEP MEETING - 14TH JULY 2016

Thank you to all those who attended the sheep abortion/fertility evening at The Union on 14th July. We hope we provided an informative evening and you weren't all overwhelmed with information. The value of vaccinating breeding animals before tupping against Enzootic Abortion and/or Toxoplasma was made abundantly clear! Vaccine costs are listed below;

Toxovax 20 Dose = £87.00 50 Dose= £218.00

2ml by intramuscular injection. For the active immunisation of susceptible breeding female sheep to reduce the effects of infection by Toxoplasma gondii, namely early embryonic death, barrenness and abortion.

Cevac Chylamdia 20 Dose = £40.00 50 Dose = £100.00

2ml by intramuscular injection. For the active immunisation of susceptible breeding female sheep as an aid in the prevention of abortion caused by Chlamydomphila abortus infection.

Enzovax 10 Dose = £23.40 20 Dose = £46.88 50 Dose = £117.19

2ml by intramuscular injection. For the active immunisation of susceptible breeding female sheep as an aid in the prevention of abortion caused by Chlamydomphila abortus infection.

Until the end of September 2016 Ceva are offering, under the AssureEwe scheme, subsidised Chlamydomphila blood tests for flocks with 100 or more breeding ewes. Contact us for further information on this scheme.



TB TESTING

We urge farmers to be organised and book early for all types of TB tests. We are now FULLY BOOKED FOR AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER and are already booking annual testing in 2017. Thank you to all of you who book in advance. Farmers trying to book in TB tests last minute will be disappointed. If you do not know your annual testing dates give us a call and we will be more than happy to help you.

Due to payment cut backs that were made due to the TB tender in 2015 now more than ever we need farmers to be organised and well prepared for their TB tests in order for us to carry on providing this service to our clients. Slow, unorganised tests jeopardize the TB service we offer and our large animal fees!

How you should help?

- Use well designed and constructed handling facilities
- Ensure your animals are correctly identified – this is a legal requirement
- Cattle should be gathered in readiness for the test
- Your herd register/cattle movement records and veterinary medicines records may be required, so please have these available for inspection
- Whilst you have the cattle gathered you may wish to undertake other management tasks. However these should not interfere with the test and routine veterinary medicines, such as wormers or vaccines, should only be given to animals once they have tested clear.
- Provide sufficient and appropriately experienced help to move groups of cattle into and through the handling facilities.



If you fail to present your cattle for testing safely and our vets considers the facilities and assistance provided to be inadequate, the test may not proceed until the issues are resolved. This could mean your test becomes overdue and movement restrictions may be applied.
